RESOLUTION

WHEREAS the Bethany Board of Education's sole mission is to provide a quality and proper education to those students enrolled in the Bethany School District;

WHEREAS, the Bethany Board of Education supports its classroom teachers and the work they do educating the children of our school district;

WHEREAS, the Bethany Board of Education understands that the teachers of Oklahoma and Bethany Public Schools are frustrated with the lack of pay and as a result the state is experiencing an extreme shortage of qualified teachers throughout Oklahoma:

WHEREAS, Oklahoma leads the nation in the deepest cuts to public education per student since 2008;

WHEREAS the education of our children should be the highest priority of the Bethany Public Schools, the Legislature and the Governor;

WHEREAS, the Bethany Board of Education supports a salary increase for public school teachers;

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Bethany Board of Education strongly supports and stands by its teachers in asking for a salary increase to a competitive salary level with surrounding states and encourages and implores the Oklahoma Legislature and the Governor to continue their work to find revenue by which to fund a significant teacher pay raise.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Superintendent is authorized to determine if circumstances warrant closing school or suspending classroom instruction for reasons beyond the control of school administration, and to take action deemed to be in the best interests of District students and staff.
